From the Pastor

Wytheville Presbyterian Church is a community of believers that extends the invitation of Christ, "Come, follow me," to people everywhere. Reflecting on the importance of community, the theologian, Henri J.M. Nouwen, writes in his book, <u>Making All</u> Things New,

The discipline of community frees us to go wherever the Spirit guides us, even to places we would rather not go. This is the real Pentecost experience. When the Spirit descended on the disciples huddling together in fear, they were set free to move out of their closed room into the world. As long as they were assembled in fear they did not yet form community. But when they had received the Spirit, they became a body of free people who could stay in communion with each other even when they were as far from each other as Rome is from Jerusalem. Thus, when it is the Spirit of God...that unites us in community, no distance of time or place can separate us.

As the community of faith God calls our church to be, we worship, serve, learn, and fellowship together, opening our hearts and minds to the Spirit that guides us in our ministry. All people are invited to our community as family and are embraced with unconditional love and acceptance.

The spirit of community is especially present among the children and youth of our church. Our ecumenical Vacation Bible School will be at St. John's Episcopal Church on June 25-28. Volunteers are needed on **Mon., June 25**, to help prepare the lunch, and during the entire VBS, to assist with crafts.

With prayer, we remember the larger gathering of our community of faith for the 223rd General Assembly on June 16-23. "Commissioners and advisory delegates from all 170 PC(USA) presbyteries, and other delegates and observers from around the world, will converge on the America's Convention Center in downtown St. Louis for celebrations, deliberations, and inspirations in support of the denomination's biennial gathering."
