A Stewardship Thought For The New Year:

"Discipleship and stewardship can sound more complicated to us than they really are" is a quote from Rich Cleveland in Serving the Master. That's because we often emphasize the results we desire instead of the means to get there. He says in reality, living as a steward of the gospel is simply the natural response of people who have developed a deep and lasting love for Jesus. When love for Christ is at the center of our lives, we want to do the things that please him and that bring joy to our own lives because we are expressing our love for him. When not motivated by love and devotion, discipleship and stewardship become burdensome chores. That sounds harsh but true. When you give your time and talents to God in whatever form, you receive more (from God) than you could ever give in response to discipleship or stewardship.

The Winter Weather Policy for our congregation includes the following guidelines:

- 1. Worship services and Sunday School on Sunday morning will be as scheduled (9:45 and 11:00 AM) regardless of the weather. If some teachers are unable to travel safely to church because of weather conditions, some classes might be consolidated for a particular Sunday.
- 2. During weekdays, all congregational events will be cancelled if the Wythe County schools are closed for the day or dismissed early because of weather These events will not be conditions. cancelled if schools are operating on a delayed schedule (when school begins 1 or 2 hours late).
- 3. During weekdays, if other activities are scheduled by smaller groups, the groups will contact their members about any changes of schedules due to weather conditions. These include: rehearsals, Presbyterian Women Circle meetings, Presbyterian Men's Praver Breakfast, and all committee meetings.

4. On weekends, if weather conditions cause the cancellation of an event, the church will communicate this information as efficiently as possible. If you have a question about a particular event, you may call Pastor John (919) 607-6448 or 228-4715).

Most important, if weather conditions are not safe because of ice, snow, or temperature, please exercise caution in making a decision about whether or not to come for a church service or activity.
