Celebrating our 200th Anniversary October 7 and 8.

200 years: Honoring the past; Inspiring the future.

Our Beginning – By the end of the 1700's, our area had been settled by many Scotch-Irish Presbyterians, both Old School and New School. The Presbyterian Church in America was working to organize these Presbyterians into congregations. As early as 1769 two congregations were organized in the eastern end of what is now Wythe County. In 1823,

Reverend James McConnell and Reverend Stephen Bovell organized the first Presbyterian congregation in the town of Evansham which later became Wytheville. Mr. Douglas Baker was elected the first elder and the Church became a member of Abingdon Presbytery. The membership called their Church Mt. Tabor Presbyterian Church. Although no deed was ever recorded, the congregation probably met in a small building in the area of what is today Third and Franklin Streets. Mt. Tabor was officially established. In the years to come, Evansham would become Wytheville and Mt. Tabor would become Wytheville Presbyterian Church. Although there were other congregations meeting in the town before 1823, very possibly the Mt. Tabor church was the first officially recorded congregation in the town. Compiled by Sid Crockett.
